### **Newhouse Announces Used Cell Phone Collection Drive**

KANSAS CITY, MO, NOVEMBER 24, 2008: Newhouse is pleased to announce the expansion of their cell phone fundraising program. Proceeds from the collection efforts will be applied to support Newhouse domestic violence shelter services.
